Incoming Tide's Festival...

Q. What is the fringe arts festival?

A. It's an outdoor performing arts festival featuring many types of performances in theatre, dance, music, comedy and eating. Performers from across the northeast participate in our year-ending bash, which culminated from events produced this year.

Q. When is the festival?

A. The festival starts Wednesday evening September 22nd with a kick-off party attended by you, our performers, the media and our sponsors. The multi-day festival ends on Sunday, September 26th. ...and its rain or shine, we will protect you from the elements...the show must go on!

Q. Where is the festival?

A. Wildcliff Manor, a cliff side property overlooking the Long Island Sound in New Rochelle, NY (*ranked #82 in Top 100 Places to Live in U.S.*). Our stage is complimented by a large grassy knoll, surrounded by nature's ambient soundscapes, while you watch the stars and the stars watch over you.

Seating is by blanket-on-lawn or bring-your-own-chair). The venue holds upwards of 500+ people with weather protection for 250 people.

Q. You want to volunteer to help with the festival?

A. We're continually searching for volunteers to work as stage managers, ushers, technical support and event coordinators. Email us at fringefest@incomingtideentertainment.com and let us know about you.

Q. What's the process for becoming a performer in the festival?

A. Any interested performer, producer, choreographer, band leader, and director must submit to us their body of work, a completed application and a nonrefundable \$25 reviewer's fee. Selected performers must provide a \$300 producing fee, where we return \$150 post performance. We provide performers a stage, tech and box office, promotion in our PR, website presence, and they receive 50% of their shows box office receipts.

Q. What's the performance schedule?

A. Performances start daily at 6:00pm on weekdays and start at 11am on weekends.

Q. How much are tickets?

A. Tickets are sold through a third party organization, provided one month before the festival. Ticket prices range from \$14 to \$18 per show. We will offer multiple shows pricing for those who wish to stay in our seats.

Q. Who is producing the festival?

A. Eric Woodlin, an emerging producer for the arts, and founder of Incoming Tide Entertainment LLC. His goal is to connect you to performances that keep you coming back for more.
